Paul gives a Double Blessing

We boast in all good conscience that holiness and sincerity, and singleness of mind, not in carnal wisdom but in the strength of God's grace, that is how we have dealt with the world and above all with you.

We write nothing to you except what you read openly and you don't have to read between the lines and nothing you can't understand. I hope your reason for boasting is that you will be proud of us as we are proud of you on the day that the Lord returns.

I was so sure of your understanding and trust, I wanted to give you a double blessing. I wanted to stop to see you on my way to Macedonia and on my return trip. You may ask why I changed my mind and think that I am like the people of

the world who say yes and really mean no. I am not that sort of person, my yes means yes because Jesus Christ the Son of God never wavers between yes and no. He is

the one I preached to you. He is divine for all of God's promises have ben fulfilled in him. That is why we say "Amen" when we give glory to God through Christ. It is God who gives us and you the ability to stand firm for Christ. He has commissioned us and identified us as his own by placing the Holy Spirit in

our hearts as the first installment of everything he will give us. With God as my witness, I am telling the truth. I did not come to Corinth for one reason, to spare you from a severe rebuke. We do not want to tell you exactly how to put your faith into practice, we want to work together with you so you will be full of joy as you stand firm in your faith.

I was utterly and unendurably crushed exceedingly depressed and we were overwhelmed: the burden was more than we could bear. It seemed to us as had though we been sentenced to death and we could find no outcome but The purpose of this death. make me lose was confidence in ourselves and place it in God who is able even to raise the dead. rescued me from so imminent a death and I am confident he will continue to deliver me. Forgive the Sinner


Paul says No TO COMING BACK NOW


despair by his excess of grief. I urge you to assure him of your love.



JUDGMENT Of The BELIEVERS WORK

We must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body according to that he has done whether it is good or bad. It is because of the solemn terror of the Lord. we work so hard to persuade others. recognizes us for what we are and I hope that you do too. We are not trying to pat ourselves on the back, we are trying to give you reason to be proud with us so that you can answer those who pride themselves surface appearances and virtues which they only appear to have although their heart is devoid of them, those who have pride in a spectacular ministry of outward show without sincerity of heart. inward reality and inward worth. If we are out of our minds, it is to bring glory to God, or if we are in our senses, it is for your good. It is Christ's love that controls us because this is the conviction that we have reached, if one man died



on behalf of all, then all thereby became dead.

His purpose in dying for all was that men, while still in life should cease to live for themselves and should live for him who for their sake died and was raised to life. Being alive should no longer mean living with our own life, but with his life who died for us and has risen again.

So we have stopped

evaluating others by what the world thinks of them. Once I mistakenly thought of Christ that way, as though he was merely a human being. Wow did that change! Those who **Christians** become become a new person, a new being. a new creation. They are not the same anymore, the old has gone the new has come.

HOW GOD WIPES OUT SIN

God sent Christ to offer his own blood as a sacrifice for our sins that we might be made holy and justified to God and be reconciled to Him through the work of Christ on the cross and his being raised again.

Remember that when a person becomes a believer, he dies to the old self, the old person, the old way of life and he becomes a new person and a new life has begun! All this newness of life is from God who brought us back to himself through what Christ did in offering his blood as a blood sacrifice for our sins for there is no forgiveness of sin without the shedding of blood. In making us holy, sinless, and completely forgiven, Christ reconciled people to the father. First to last, this has been the work of God. He reconciled us to himself through Christ and he enlisted us in the service of reconciliation. That is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to himself instead of counting their sins against them and he has entrusted to us the message of reconciliation. Therefore, I am an ambassador for Christ, as though God were appealing to you through me. We implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God. He made Christ who knew no sin to be made to be sin on our behalf. Christ was innocent of sin and yet for our sake God made him one with the sinfulness of man so that in Christ we might be made good, holy and justified of God. This is our appeal to you, Don't let God's word be wasted on you, you have received the grace of God: do not let it go for nothing. At the time for



Devil? How can a believer be a partner with an unbeliever?

What union can there be between God's temple and idols? For we are the temple of the living God. As God said,

"I will live in them and walk in and among

them. I will be their God. and they will be my people. (Lev 26:12; Ezek 37:27) Therefore, come out from them and separate yourselves from them, says the Lord Don't touch their filthv things, and - 1 will welcome you. (Isa 52:11; Ezek 20:34) Ane I will be vour Father and you will be my sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty." (2 Sam 7:14)

Yes, and by more than his arrival, by the comfort which you had been to him. When he told me how you longed to see me, your morning at my reproof, and your zeal on my behalf, I rejoiced even more. I am no longer sorry that I sent the letter to you, though I was sorry for a time, for I know that it was painful to you for a little while. Now I am glad I sent it, not because it hurt you,, but because the pain caused you

to have remorse and change your ways. It is the kind of sorrow that God wants his people to have. For God can use sorrow in our lives to help us turn away from sin and seek salvation.

I REJOICE THEREFORE THAT I HAVE CONFIDENCE IN YOU IN ALL THINGS.



The work of Godly sorrow is repentance which leads to salvation and leaves no regrets but the work of worldly sorrow leads to death. Notice

how serious this God related sorrow has made you, how disgusted with wrong you are how determined to punish the offender and vindicate me you were. In every point

you have cleared yourself.

CALL TO BE AN ABUNDANT GIVER

When I wrote to you, it was not on account of the man who was doing wrong nor was it for the one who was wronged but in order to let you realize before God how deeply you are devoted to us. Although I have been boasting a little to him about you, you did not put me to The boast that I shame. made to Titus proved true. His affection for you is all the more increased by memory of you all in the submissiveness you shewed and the respect and reverence with which you treated him.I am profoundly glad to have my confidence in you so fully proved.

JESUS WAS RICH YET FOR YOUR SAKES HE BECAME POOR THAT YOU THROUGH HIS POVERTY MIGHT BE RICH.

I must tell you brothers and sisters, how the favor of God has been shown in the churches of Macedonia. The troubles they have been through have tried them hard, yet in all this they have been so exuberantly happy that from the depths of their poverty they have shown themselves lavishly generous. They have given not only according to their means but beyond their means and that of their own free will. They begged us to allow them the privilege of

helping to support and supply the needs of the brothers in Christ. First of all, they themselves to dedicated the Lord and then to us, as God's appointed ministers, for whatever directions God might give them. This led me to ask Titus to complete the arrangements for the same gracious contribution among yourselves as it was he who started it. I am not saying you must do it even though other churches are eager to do it, but it is one way to prove your love is real. You know of the love and grace of the Lord Jesus Christ. He was rich yet for your sakes he became poor that you through his poverty might be rich.

It is best for you now to complete what a year ago you began to do and to desire. Finish your work according to your means. If there is a willing mind, a man's gift is measured in comparison with what he has and not

what he has not. Of course, I don't mean that others should be relieved to an extent that you are yourselves in distress,



but by the way of reciprocity, your surplus should at the present contribute to their deficiency and theirs to yours. As it is written, "Those who gathered a lot had nothing left over and those who gathered little had enough." (Exod 16:18)






Remember this, a farmer who plants only a few seeds will get a small crop. He who sows sparingly and grudgingly will also reap sparingly and grudgingly, and he who sows generously and that blessings may come to someone will also reap generously and with blessings. But the one who

plants generously will get a generous crop.

You must each make up your mind how much should give. For God loves the person who gives cheerfully. And God will generously provide all you need. Then you will always have everything you need and plenty left over to share with others. As the scriptures say in Ps 112:9, "Godly people give generously to the poor. Their good deeds will never **be forgotten.**" As God, who supplies seed for the sower and turns that seed into bread to eat will give you the seed of generosity to sow and for harvest, the satisfying bread of good deeds done. supplies you with seed and multiplies it and increases the benefits through your giving. You enlarge your harvest when you give! And you will be enriched so that you can give even more generously and when your gifts are taken to those in need, they will break out in thanksgiving to God. PAUL Tells of Spiritual Authority

I Paul appeal to you personally by the gentleness and kindness of Christ, the Paul who is so humble to you face when he is with you, but so bold in dealing with you when he is far away. I beg vou to not make me take as bold an attitude when I come. I may have to be bold with those who still think that I act from motives of the flesh. We live in the world but it is no worldly warfare that we are waging. For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal. but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds: our weapons are not merely human but divinely demolish potent t o strongholds. Our battle is to bring down every deceptive fantasy and every imposing defense that men against the true knowledge of God and causing every thought to come under the

prepared to punish all rebellion when once you have put yourselves in our hands. The trouble with you is that

you make your accisions on the basis of appearance. You must recognize that we belong to Christ just as much as those who proudly declare that they belong to Christ. The authority that God gave us is to build you up, not tear you down so you must not think of me as one who writes threats in letters. Some say that Paul is forceful in letters but his personality and personal



We do not try to take credit for someone else's We hope that the work. growth of your faith will allow me to enlarge the range of my appointed sphere. Then we will be able to preach the gospel in places where no one else has been. scriptures say. "The person who wishes to boast should boast only of what the Lord has done." If you boast, boast about the Lord. For the Lord's approval of a man is not dependent on his opinion of himself but on the Lord's opinion of him.

Paul Warns of False Teachers

Bear with me as I continue to talk on. I feel a divine jealousy on your behalf because I betrothed you to one only husband that I present you as a chaste virgin to Christ. I fear that just as the serpent by his cunning deceived Eve. your thoughts will be led astray from their single hearted devotion Christ. ۱f some preaches newcomer Jesus or you received a spirit different from the Holy Spirit you

received and a different gospel than the gospel I preached. I am not inferior to the very greatest of apostles though I am no trained orator I certainly do not lack in knowledge. At all times. have made myself known to you. Was it my offense that I made no charge for preaching the gospel of God lowering myself to help in raising you. robbed other churches



letting them pay me so that I could work for you. When I was with you and in want, I was a burden no man: for the on brethren from Macedonia supplied my wants when they came. In this way I kept myself from being a burden unto you in any way. I do this to cut the ground from under those who claim that they are different from no me. these people For are false apostles. They have fooled you! I am not surprised. Even Satan can disguise himself as an angel of light, his servants can also by pretending to be ministers of light. In the end they will get every bit of the punishment they deserve.

I have trials!

They brag of being a Hebrew, Israelite, a seed of Abraham, a minister, So Am I and much more. I have had more toil and imprisonment and beatings, five times I had 39 stripes, three times beaten with rods by the perils Romans, robbers, water and false brethren. I have endured hardship, hunger, thirst and have known cold and nakedness. exhaustion, pain, and lack of clothing. Besides that I feel the daily burdens of the churches. I managed escaped from to Demascus by beina lowered in a basket from a hole in the wall. Not for my glory but for God's.

Paul's vision from the Lord

Let me tell about the visions and revelations I received form the Lord. I was caught up into the third Heaven fifteen years ago. Whether in the body or out of the body I do not know, only God knows. I simply know that in the body or out of the body, I was caught up to the third heaven and heard sacred secrets which no human lips can repeat. This is an experience that is worth boasting about but I am not going to do that. I am going to boast only about my weaknesses. If I were to boast I would not be just a braggart because I would be speaking the truth. I abstain from boasting of it that no one form a higher opinion of me than is justified by what he sees in me and



hears from me. **To** me being puffed up and too much elated by the greatness of these revelations there was given me a thorn in the flesh. instrument of Satan to discipline me so that I as should not think too highly myself. Three times I sought the Lord and begged him to remove this His from me. answer to me was, "My grace, favor, mercy is enough and for you sufficient against any danger and to enable you to bear the trouble. For my strength and power are made perfect and completed in your



weakness. Therefore, will all the more gladly glory in my weaknesses and immittees that the strength and power of Christ may rest as to pitch a tent and dwell upon me. So for the sake of Christ I take pleasure in the infirmities, insults, hardships, and distresses for when I am weak in the flesh then I am truly strong and powerful in divine strength.

You have made me feel like a fool boasting like I am not at all this. inferior to those super apostles even though I am nothing at all. I gave you proof by God himself many signs and miracles and wonders among you. The only thing that I did not do that I do in other churches is to become a burden on you. Please forgive me for that. I am coming a third time to you and I do not want what you have but I want you!

I gave you proof by God himself by many signs and wonders and miracles among you.

I will gladly spend myself for your spiritual good even though it seems that the more I love you, the less you love me. We tell this as Christ's you servants and we know that God is listening. I am afraid that when I come, I will have to grieve because many of you who sinned earlier have repented of the not impurity, sexual vice and



pleasure. As the scriptures say, "The facts of every case must be established by testimony of of two or three witnesses." (Deut 19:15) I warned those in sin on my second visit. Next time I will not spare them.I will give you all the proof you want that Christ through speaks Christ is not weak in his dealings with you, he is a mighty power among you, Although he died on the cross in weakness, He lives through the mighty power of God. We are also weak as he was weak, but we live in him and have God's power, a mighty force! Examine yourself, to see if your faith is real. If you cannot tell that Jesus Christ is among you and in you, it means you have failed the test. We pray for your restoration to maturity.

I close my letter with the words: Rejoice, change your ways. Encourage each other. Live in harmony and peace. Then the God of love and peace will be with you. May the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.
