
I LOOK FORWARD TO DEATH


REJOICE IN HUMBLE SERVICE

The Sevenfold Self-humbling of Christ Jesus

et the same attitude and purpose and humble mind be in you which is in Christ. Let him be your example of humility. For our sakes, he became poor. Live in unity and in harmony, to lay aside discord as well as selfish personal ambitions, pride, and desire for prominence and humble yourselves in your heart with selfless desire to serve. For Jesus who did not need to grasp at being equal with God because He had it as a right! He laid it down willingly for the sake of men. he made a personal sacrifice in the incarnation

to empty himself of the glory of his divinity. he emptied himself of his deity in order to take on his humanity. He took on the form of a servant—a slave, not to act like a man but to be a real man. After he had appeared in human form, He humbled Himself and carried His obedience to the extreme of death, even death of the cruel, painful cross as a blood sacrifice for the sins of men that they could be saved.



Day by day, your life must be more completely perfected. What God offers, man must take. It is never God who withholds salvation, it is always man who robs himself of it. REJOICE IN THE LORD

aul points out two things about the joy of a believer. The indestructibility of Christian joy. Even in the face of persecution, and possible death, there is an indestructible joy in the heart of the believer. In John 16, Jesus said, "Your joy no man taketh away from you." That is because your joy is in



the Lord. The basis for joy is in the continual presence and company of Jesus in the life of the believer. We can lose all of our things and all of our family or friends, but we can never lose Jesus. I have joy because all of the threats, problems, and discomforts put together can not separate us from the love of God.

The great saving truths of Christianity do not change. We cannot hear them too often. If you eat bread and drink water every day, then you must also feed your spirit every day that you grow in the things of God. People want new and unheard of ideas at every turn, but you are saved by God's grace through faith the same as all other believers were saved and all future believers will be saved until the return of Jesus.

Paul is saying that he had everything that the world wants, power, pres-

tige, family name, wealth, and all that goes with the things of this world but the things that were gain, are counted as loss for Christ. It is better to be in Christ and in his will than to have all of the things of this world and all of the wealth and fleshly desires that one can dream of. He said that he had those things and lost them for the cause of Christ. Not only was he not sad about it, he was in joy that he had found the one real and true treasure of a great price which is the knowledge of Jesus Christ. Without Christ, one is very poor. With Him, you have the greatest treasure that one can have in this world and lifetime. If you have Christ, what more is there and what greater thing can you have than eternal salvation?

There is nothing to have pride about in things or in the keeping of the law, these were a total loss. Paul is saying that he tried to find righteousness or a right relationship with God but could never on his ability build up a goodness good enough. Then he gave that up and came to God in humble faith and found that fellowship that he had searched for for so long and had never found. A right relationship with God is not based on law but on faith in Jesus. It is not earned by man but is given by God.

eware of the dogs! In the middle east at the time of Paul, dogs were wild, feeding on refuse and filth of the streets and without owners. The Bible uses the word dogs to describe the nonbeliever and in the Jewish mind, nothing could be lower. This idea is strange to a culture that loves and cares for its pets. Paul is saying to take care not to be fooled by evil teachers that do not worship God in Spirit and in truth. Jewish teachers were teaching that salvation is by the keeping of the law while Paul was

teaching that salvation is available and free to everyone who believes in Christ by the grace of God. Jews taught the keeping of laws. Paul taught that the only righteousness comes by casting yourself freely upon the grace of God. The other thing was circumcision which was necessary for the Jewish law. Paul taught that the truly circumcised are believers with an inner spiritual circumcision. Christian worship is a thing of the Spirit.



Right now pray that God will help you to keep your mind on the things of heaven and not the things of this world and in your weakness, He shall supply all of your needs and all of the power to overcome the problems of the day so that your compass always points in a Godly direction and your walk follows and your mind is fixed on Him. follow. You must look upon the things of God to arrive at your actions and not follow the ways of the world because they lead to destruction. Reflect upon the things of God and allow only those things to shape your actions and conduct.
